ERC annually served 2,308 unduplicated clients from Georgia's 159 counties, despite the COVID-19 pandemic. 81% of these clients reside in the metropolitan Atlanta area.

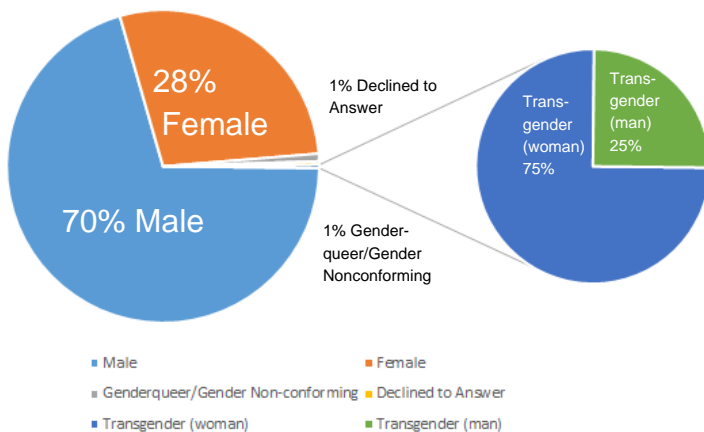
The mission of ERC is to provide programs, services, and community-level solutions that improve the health-related quality of life for the communities we are privileged to serve.

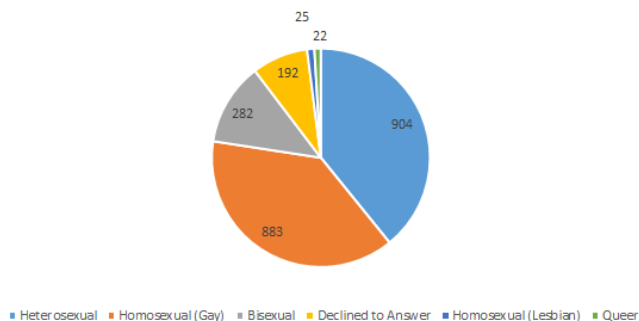
