Under its Prevention Education program component, ERC provides life coaching and skill building programs and community outreach services across six public health districts in Georgia. During 2012, ERC conducted 20 HIV and sexually transmitted infection (STI) and teenage pregnancy prevention programs and workshops for medically and economically disadvantaged clients with high-risk behaviors. ERC has several programs, such as VOICES, and SIHLE (Sisters Informing, Healing, Living, and Empowering). A total of 150 unduplicated participants attended these sessions and 570 safer sex kits were directly distributed at homeless shelters, transitional housing programs, mental health and substance abuse outpatient facilities, job readiness programs, correctional facilities, foster homes, alternative schools, recreational centers, and health fairs. ERC also offers capacity building programs that provide professional development and training opportunities, expand community resources, and establish solid foundations from which to address health related disparities for staff, volunteers, and other non-profit organizations. ERC conducted four (4) capacity building sessions which covered HIV Basics, Rapid HIV Testing, the Science of HIV topics, and Peer Educator Workshops, which assist people living with HIV and AIDS to become effective peer health educators.

4b (Code:) (Expenses \$ 63,394. including grants of \$ 0.) (Revenue \$ 0.)

Under its Counseling, Testing, and Referral (CTR) services component, ERC administers testing and treatment services in its Comprehensive Intervention Clinic, through the Reproductive Health Initiative. During 2012, ERC provided HIV, Chlamydia, Gonorrhea Hepatitis C, Herpes I & Herpes II, counseling, testing, and treatment services to 758 clients. An estimated 3.3% of clients were HIV infected and linked to primary care services through Ryan White Clinics. Approximately 4.8% of clients were infected with Gonorrhea and 11.2% were infected with Chlamydia. 2.9% were infected with Syphilis and 57% of clients were who were screened for Hepatitis C, Herpes I or Herpes II were found to be positive. Of those infected, 83.3% received treatment and and 10% returned for followup testing. ERC served individuals residing in 25 counties across 10 of Georgia's public health districts. In kind donations of toiletries, condoms, lubricants, and literature, in addition to purchased items, were distributed to clients as part of their safer sex kits. The vast majority of support for this component was provided by volunteers.

Under its Support Services program component, ERC provides health advocacy services, support groups, and linkages to primary care for HIV positive clients through its EmpowerLink Program A Dose of Hope Program, Women's Support Group Program, and the "Enrichment! Responsibility! Choices! (E.R.C.)" Men's Support Group Program. ERC uses the ARTAS Linkage to Case Management (ALCM) and WILLOW evidence-based interventions. During 2012, 30 HIV infected clients were served through these volunteer supported programs.
