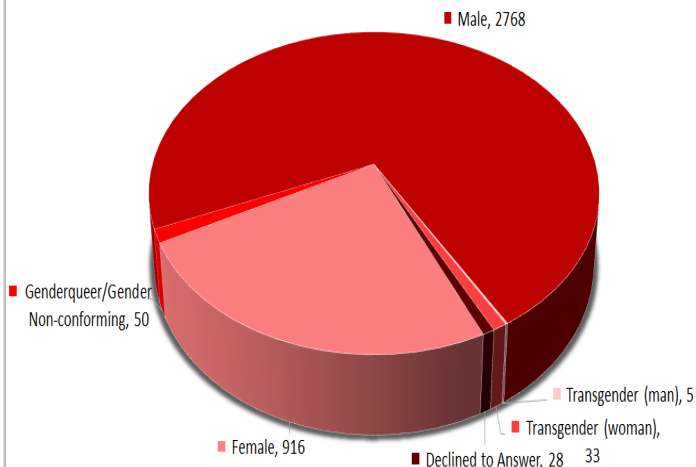
The mission of ERC is to provide programs, services, and community-level solutions that improve the health-related quality of life for the communities we are privileged to serve.

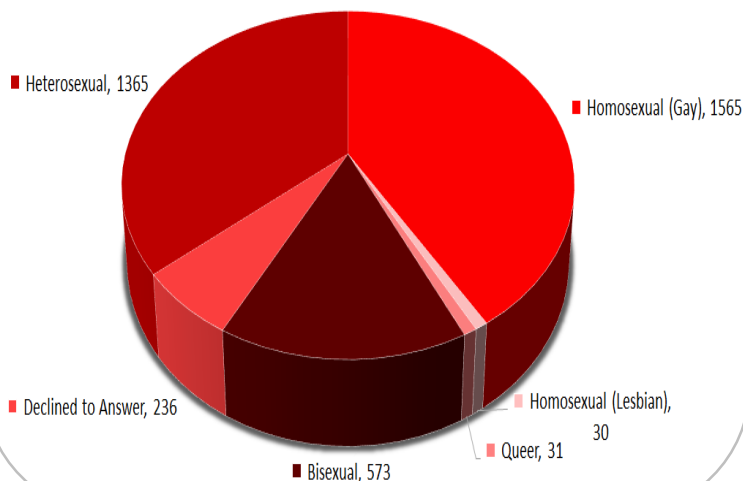
